Primary Concerns	Speeding during off-peak hours, gridlock during peak times, difficult to exit driveways, heavy traffic, buses, truck route violations, stop violations, passing on left, left turns at Mission St., thru traffic at Huntington Dr., vehicle noise, merging traffic north of Huntington Dr.		
Primary Goals	Reduce speeding, enforce vehicle laws, reduce traffic volume, lower speed limit, one northbound lane at Huntington Dr. only,

15	Install solar-powered red beacons on stop signs at Ashborne/Winthrop	Better stop sign compliance (24/7)	Flashing light may bother residents unless dimmed at night.	\$5,000
16	Install larger stop signs at Ashborne/Winthrop	Better stop sign compliance (24/7)	None.	\$500
17	Directional signs at Huntington/ Atlantic/Garfield (See also Garfield #2)	Divert cut-thru traffic, reduce noise and pollution (24/7)	Possible increase on adjacent streets	\$5,000
18	Electronic speed awareness sign south of Marengo (Southbound)	Reduce speeds (24/7)	Sign aesthetics in residential area	\$10,000
19	Electronic speed awareness sign north of Plymouth (Northbound)	Reduce speeds (24/7)	Sign aesthetics in residential area	\$10,000
20	Flashing Red traffic signals during off-peak periods at Monterey and Wilson (Adjust as needed to prevent back-up)	Discourage cut-thru traffic, reduce speeds (24/7)	Increase in noise/pollution at signals, obstruction of nearby driveways, possible diversion	Nominal
21	Countdown pedestrian signals at Mission St.	Improve pedestrian safety (24/7)	None	\$2,000
23	Install street trees	Reduce speeds, beautify street (24/7)	Ongoing maintenance	\$20,000
24	Targeted enforcement	Improve traffic law compliance (Peak)	Limited police resources	Nominal
27	Plant trees in entry median at Los Robles Avenue north of Huntington Dr.	Reduce speeds, beautify street (24/7)	Ongoing maintenance	Nominal
