<b>Primary Concerns</b>	Protect existing Huntington Dr. medians, speeding, street lighting needed, Stoneman traffic, downhill speed, blind corner at Pasqualito, safety at alley and driveways, stop sign violations at Old Mill and Mission, non-resident parking north of Mission St.		
<b>Primary Goals</b>	Reduce speeding, street lighting, lower speed limit, stop parking intrusion north of alley, stop sign compliance		
Traffic Volume	4,835 to 6,460 vehicles per day	Prevailing Speed	37mph (NB), 32mph (SB)

5	Mobile electronic speed awareness sign at Winthrop Rd. (Northbound)	Reduce speeds (24/7)	Sign aesthetics in residential area	\$10,000
6	Stop sign enforcement	Improve compliance (Peak)	Citations to residents	Nominal
7	High visibility crosswalks at Mission	Improve stop compliance, pedestrian safety (24/7)	Needs curb ramps	\$6,000
8	Install street lighting (on existing wood poles between Mission and Wilson)	Improve nighttime safety (24/7)	Light scatter near residences, tax assessment	\$80,000 plus energy cost
