

# Annual Fourth of July Celebration!

The City of San Marino will hold its Annual Fourth of July Celebration on Saturday, July 4 at Lacy Park (1485 Virginia Road). The community is invited to attend this patriotic event, which will feature ongoing game booths and bingo from 4 to 7 pm, a community parade at 5 pm (read details below), stage entertainment from 5:30 to 9 pm and a fireworks display at approximately 9 pm.

The Virginia Road entrance to the park will open at **7 am**. No entrance will be allowed via St. Albans Road until 3 pm. Guests may reserve areas using blankets, chairs and ropes. No stakes will be permitted in the ground.

## How to get your 4th of July Wristbands!

**Residents:** Cut-out coupons can only be redeemed at the San Marino Recreation Department, Monday-Friday, June 15 to July 2 from 8 am to 5 pm and Saturday, June 27 from 9 am to 3 pm. Residents may purchase additional wristbands for \$5 each, through Thursday, July 2. **There will be no ticket sales on Friday, July 3.**

**Wristbands purchased on the Fourth of July are \$20 each, for residents and non-residents.**

**Non-residents:** You may purchase wristbands at the Recreation Department for \$15 per person, Monday-Friday, June 22 to July 2 from 8 am to 5 pm and at the Saturday, June 27 from 9 am to 3 pm.

Door-to-door shuttle service will be available for senior citizens, ages 65 and older. Service is limited, and pre-registration is required. Registration will begin on Monday, June 15. To register for shuttle service, or for more information about the celebration, please call (626) 403-2200.
