What we are about

The City of San Marino's preschool program has been addressing the need for a community-based, part time preschool for over 10 years. We offer classes that are designed to help build self-esteem, social skills and promote independence in a safe environment for toddlers – Pre-K. Some activities include creative play, circle time, snack time, enrichment time, and outside play. Children 17 months old – 4.9 years old can attend up to 12 hours per week. Children 4.9 years old and older can attend up to 16 hours per week.

Classes

"Tiny" Toddlers Age: Child must turn 17 months old by September 1st 2017

This class is designed for the toddler who is ready to separate from their parents in a safe environment with other young toddlers. Your child will be introduced to cooperative play and pre-academics with an emphasis on first-time experiences. Diapers are welcome! Staff will assist with potty training. Diapers, wipes and a change of clothes must be labeled in a bag.

"Too Cool" Twos & Threes Age: Child must turn 2 years old by September 1st

This program will provide your child with the opportunity to develop social and classroom skills while making new friends. As your child expresses independence, we will introduce them to a world of learning, sharing, and exploring. A monthly curriculum calendar is followed which involves letters, numbers, shapes, and colors. Diapers are welcome! Staff will assist with potty training. Diapers, wipes and a change of clothes must be labeled in a bag.

"Terrific" Threes & Fours Age: Child must turn 3 years old by September 1st

This class provides the opportunity for children to grow and learn together as they advance in their preschool experience. Through independent exploration, structured activities, and hands-on learning we provide the opportunity for your child to develop a variety of skills and knowledge in areas like literacy, mathematics, science, and social skills. Children must be fully potty trained. No pull-ups.
