Park Safety Rules

- ★ Wristbands are required for entry to Lacy Park on Wednesday, July 4 starting at 7 a.m.
- ★ No sticks, stakes, poles, spikes or posts shall be inserted into any landscape area, including grass areas.
- ★ Do not move park picnic tables to your area.
- ★ No drop cloths or plastic sheeting is permitted on the park grass areas. “Saved” areas can only be marked with blankets and/or chairs placed on the ground.
- ★ All canopies or tents must be taken down by 5 p.m. to avoid blocking the view of the fireworks display.
- ★ No bike riding, skateboarding, etc. is allowed after the parade is over.
- ★ All dogs must be kept on a leash and attended at all times.
- ★ No open flames or barbecues are permitted at any time.
- ★ No fireworks are allowed.
- ★ Access into the fireworks ring is strictly prohibited.
- ★ Wristbands must be worn at all times while in Lacy Park. You cannot enter at **any** time without a wristband.
- ★ Alcoholic beverages are prohibited at Lacy Park.
- ★ Flashlights are recommended.
- ★ Insect repellent is recommended. For current vector control info. go to glacvcd.org or call (562) 944-9656.
- ★ **PLEASE** reserve only the area you need and be considerate of your neighbors.

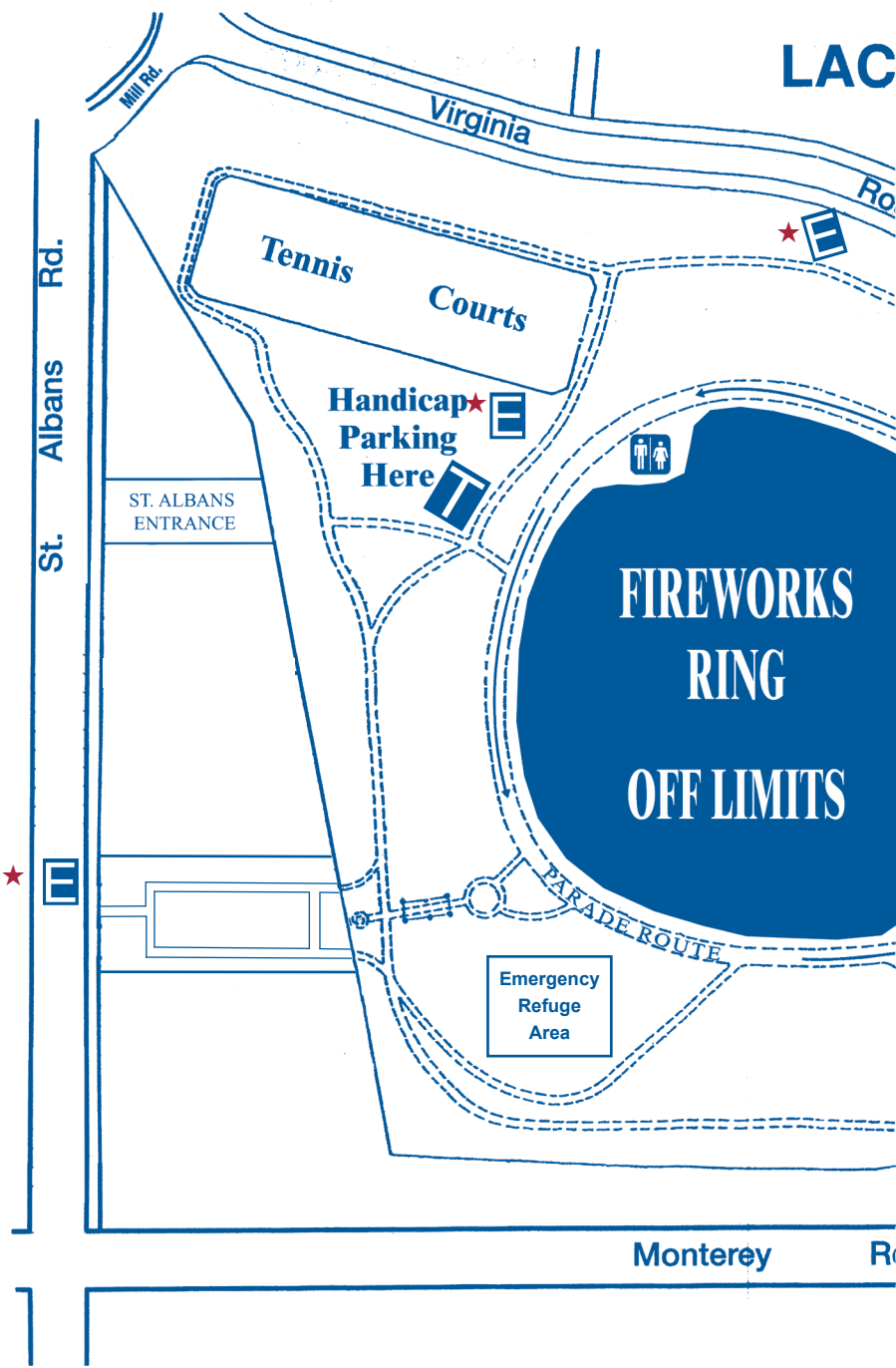

General Information

- ★ **Park Entrance:** Wristbands required for entry starting at 7 a.m. The Virginia Road entrance will be open at 7 a.m. The St. Albans entrance will open at 3 p.m.
- ★ **Picnic Areas:** First come, first select. Please be neighborly and do not take up more area than you need and do not disturb your neighbor's area. Areas may be marked off with blankets, ropes placed on the ground or chairs. No stakes are allowed in the ground to mark off areas.
- ★ **Drop Off Zone:** There is a designated drop-off zone along the Virginia Road entrance. Vehicles left unattended in this area will be subject to a parking ticket and towing at the owner's expense.
- ★ **Handicap Parking:** Limited handicap parking is available in the parking lot on the St. Albans side of the park. Only those with handicap placards and state-issued identification cards will be permitted to park their vehicles in the designated areas.
- ★ **First Aid:** Fire Department personnel will be staged adjacent to the children's playground and a first aid station will be set up by the War Memorial.
- ★ **Children:** Parents should carefully supervise their children at all times. Identification wristbands are recommended for all children. The entrance wristbands can accommodate emergency phone number information and/or whatever information you deem appropriate. **If you cannot find a family member, please proceed immediately to the police tent for assistance. See the map on page 6.**

General Information

- ★ **Traffic Pattern:** Traffic flow will run southbound on Virginia Road and in both directions on St. Albans Road. Please observe temporary traffic and no parking signs along these routes to encourage a steady flow of traffic.
- ★ **Wristband Sales:**
 - Residents:** \$5 each. Proof of residency will be requested; bring an identification card or a utility bill with your address. Children 2 and under are free.
 - Non-Residents:** \$15 each. Children 2 and under are free.
 - Sales - June 11 through July 3:** Please note that days and times vary at the locations below.
 - June 11-July 3, **Recreation Department**, Mon.-Thu. 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
 - June 18-July 3, **Crowell Public Library**, Mon.-Thu. 10 a.m. to 9 p.m., Fri.-Sat. 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., Sun. 1 p.m. to 5 p.m.
 - June 11-July 3, **City Hall**, Mon.-Thu. 7 a.m. to 2 p.m., Fri. 7 a.m. to 11 a.m.
 - July 4 Sales:** \$20 for both residents and non-residents. Children 2 and under are free.

Active Military Banner Program

**Recognizing and honoring
those who serve**

Apply by Monday, July 9, 2018

The City of San Marino will once again honor community members who are actively serving in the U.S. Armed Forces or attending a military academy by proudly displaying personalized street banners on poles throughout the center of town from early September through early November. New banners will be printed for new and returning qualified applicants. The banners will then be stored and displayed yearly while the service person is on active duty or attending an academy.

The program is offered at no cost to the military members with the hope that the project can be funded entirely through donations. In order to qualify, honorees must meet two general guidelines:

- ★ The honoree must be on active duty with any branch of the U.S. Armed Forces (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard or National Guard) or be attending a military service academy.
- ★ The honoree must be a current or former San Marino resident, live in the San Marino Unified School District boundary or be a high school graduate of either San Marino High School or Southwestern Academy.

Please Remember the Following Guidelines and Safety Rules:

- ★ Check-in begins at 3:30 p.m. on San Marino Ave. at Titan Travel.
- ★ All cars are to park in the 1400 San Marino Avenue area (off of Sierra Madre).
- ★ Parade organizers will determine the order of entries and will provide identification number of each entry.
- ★ The parade begins promptly at 4:45 p.m. The parade heads west on Monterey Road to Virginia Road, then north to Lacy Park. Entries will circle the inside of the park once, then they must exit the park.
- ★ Motorized vehicles must be licensed for operation on public streets. All drivers must be legally licensed.
- ★ **No water balloons, water guns or other sprays will be allowed. No candy or other objects may be thrown. No objects are allowed to be thrown from a vehicle to a person.**
- ★ Identification signage is welcome, but no advertising or political views may be displayed.

Entries are limited to San Marino residents, commercial enterprises serving San Marino, clubs, organizations and their employees.
