SUBJECT: DRAFT HUNTINGTON DRIVE SAFE STREETS CORRIDOR PLAN

RECOMMENDATION

Provide recommendations of which short- and long-term measures the City Council could consider in future capital budgets to improve roadway safety along the Huntington Drive corridor.

BACKGROUND

The Southern California Association of Governments (SCAG) has prepared a draft report with recommendations to improve roadway safety along Huntington Drive based on a 2015 sustainable transportation planning grant that SCAG received. The City's participation included forming an ad-hoc citizen's advisory group, providing meeting facilities, and related in-kind matches. In late 2015 SCAG hired KOA of Monterey Park to develop the plan attached herewith.

No construction is directly involved with this planning study. It is simply an analysis available to the City and school district, based on community input, of options available that could be implemented by future capital improvements and funded with a variety of state and federal grant programs.

A brief summary of the recommendations will be made and the Commissioners will be requested to provide recommendations for consideration by the City Council as described above.

Attached for your information is the grant application for the study and the draft report.
