

Prowling / Residential Burglary

On 08/22/12 at approximately 1250hrs, a resident in the 1000 block of Rosalind Rd. pulled along side her driveway. **She** observed a dark colored Nissan sedan occupied by a Female Black parked in her driveway. **The** resident spoke to the female who claimed she was delivering chocolates, and asked if they were for her. **The** resident told her she was expecting no such delivery, and the female got on her cell phone. The female acted as though she was contacting her boss about the delivery. **The female apologized and told her she would pull out of her driveway.**

Moments later, the resident noticed a Male Black in her rear yard who appeared to be urinating. The resident confronted the male subject who said he came from the neighbor's yard, and quickly walked away. **He** walked to the street, and then Eastbound where it is believed he was picked up by the female driver. **The** resident that contacted SMPD but responding officers were unable to locate the vehicle. **A** license plate number was written down by the victim, and the SMPD Detective Bureau conducted follow-up on the vehicle in the City of Pasadena.

On 08/22/12 at approximately 1330hrs, a resident in the 800 block of Sierra Madre Blvd. returned to his residence and discovered that unknown suspect(s) had forced entry into the home. **Upon** closer inspection, the resident found it had been burglarized and miscellaneous jewelry, money, and clothing were taken. **The** area was canvassed but no suspect(s) were seen or heard.

It is believed that the suspect(s) in the two incidents may be related. **The** resident from the 800 block of Sierra Madre Blvd. was gone for a period of time, so it is difficult to determine an exact time.
