

**Students Are Walking and Biking to School
Starting Wednesday, August 21, 2013**



There are five schools on Huntington Drive in San Marino. The speed limit along Huntington Drive is 40 mph, *except* when students are present. Then the speed limit is lowered to 25 mph. Generally, students will be present from 7:30 a.m. - 8:45 a.m. during the morning commute and from 2:30 p.m. - 3:30 p.m. after school. During the first week of school, both Carver and Valentine Elementary Schools will be on a minimum day schedule, so students will be released at 12:30 p.m.

The San Marino Police will be extra vigilant about motorists who fail to stop for pedestrians, exceed posted speed limits and violate school zone speed limits. As a part of the Safe Routes to School Program, new Speed Awareness signs are now operational along Huntington Drive.

Please drive cautiously and be ever vigilant for the safety of our children returning to school.
