For the period of Sunday, June 16, 2019, through Saturday, June 22, 2019, the Police Department responded to 582 calls for service. No residential burglaries and no attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

Sunday, June 16, 2019

3:24 A.M. – CVC 22651(o)(1)(A) / VEHICLE STORAGE / HUNTINGTON DRIVE / COURT IN THE CITY OF SOUTH PASADENA: A traffic enforcement stop was conducted for expired registration. The vehicle's registration expired in April of 2018. The vehicle was stored.

Monday, June 17, 2019

8:56 A. M. - P.C. 664 / 484 / ATTEMPT / PETTY THEFT / 2800 BLOCK SHEFFIELD: SMPD Officer arrive to the above location to reference a report of attempt petty theft. SMPD Officer contacted the victim. Victim stated at approximately 1030 pm last night, he heard his dog barking. He looked out the window of his house but did not see anything. At approximately 0840 hours, victim went to his truck and noticed someone had cut the bolts to the metal storage box that was fastened to the rear bed of his truck. It appears someone tried to steal the utility box but was unsuccessful.

A small baggie was located on S/WALLACE with a substance which was consistent with black tar heroin. The subject had a broken alcohol bottle and appeared to be intoxicated and unable to care for himself.

Saturday June 22, 2019

CRI8-0805 / WARRANT ARREST / GLENDALE POLICE DEPARTMENT: SMPD officer responded to the Glendale Police Department (GPD) jail regarding a warrant pick-up. Hugo Cardenas (Los Angeles) was contacted by the GPD and found to have two outstanding warrants from this agency and the LAPD. At approximately 0930 hours, the resident entered his vehicle and found it had been ransacked. His wife's SUV which was also parked on the driveway was also ransacked. Taken was miscellaneous items.
