For the period of Sunday, May 26, 2019, through Saturday, June 1, 2019, the Police Department responded to 581 calls for service. One residential burglary and no attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

Sunday, May 26, 2019
