For the period of Sunday, August 2, 2020 through Saturday, August 8, 2020, the Police Department responded to 437 calls for service. One residential burglary, one commercial burglary, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

Sunday, August 2, 2020

12:06 A.M. / CVC 14601.1A / H&S 11364A / DRIVING WITH A SUSPENDED LICENSE / UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF DRUG PARAPHERNALIA / CHELSEA ROAD / HUNTINGTON DRIVE: Vehicle was stopped for a vehicle code violation. During the subsequent investigation, it was determined that the driver, Garcia, Magdaleno (DOB 3/21/1978, Los Angeles), was driving on a suspended license and the passenger, Salgero, Eber Alexis (DOB 3/20/86, Gardena). Garcia and Salgero were issued an own recognizance citation and released at the scene.
