For the period of Sunday, August 23, 2020 through Saturday, August 29, 2020, the Police Department responded to 437 calls for service. One residential burglary, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

Sunday, August 23, 2020

6:30 A.M. / SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES / 2600 BLOCK OF WALLINGFORD ROAD: Unknown male subject is seen on video surveillance approach the front porch of the home and bang on the front door before fleeing. The reporting party stated that similar incidents occurred at 1:00 AM and at 3:00 AM.
