For the period of Sunday, August 30, 2020 through Saturday, September 5, 2020, the Police Department responded to 522 calls for service. One residential burglary, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

Sunday, August 30, 2020

Oroujian was issued own recognizance citations and released at the scene.
