For the period of Sunday, December 29, 2019 through Saturday, January 4, 2020, the Police Department responded to 623 calls for service. Zero residential burglaries, one commercial burglary, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

Sunday, December 29, 2019

00:10 A.M./ 902T/ NON-INJURY TRAFFIC COLLISION/ HUNTINGTON DRIVE/GRANADA AVENUE: A solo vehicle struck a light pole.
