For the period of Sunday, February 16, 2020 through Saturday, February 22, 2020, the Police Department responded to 589 calls for service. Two residential burglaries, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.
