For the period of Sunday, January 10, 2021 through Saturday, January 16, 2021, the Police Department responded to 441 calls for service. Zero residential burglaries, zero commercial burglaries, and one attempt residential burglary occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

**Sunday, January 10, 2021**

**2:18 P.M. / PC 594 / VANDALISM / 1000 BLOCK OF HUNTINGTON DRIVE:** Unknown suspect(s) used an unknown liquid and used it to write on the front window of the building, causing permanent damage.

The suspect failed to yield and a pursuit ensued and was terminated due to the suspect's erratic driving. The suspect then became involved in a traffic collision and fled on foot. The suspect, Gonzales, Marc Anthony (DOB 4/4/1997, Lomita) was located and found to be in possession of synthetic drugs and paraphernalia. Gonzales was transported to Pasadena Jail for processing and booking.
