For the period of Sunday, January 12, 2019 through Saturday, January 18, 2020, the Police Department responded to 583 calls for service. Two residential burglaries, zero commercial burglary, and one attempt residential burglary occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

**Sunday, January 12, 2020**

**9:13 A.M. / 901T / INJURY TRAFFIC COLLISION / HUNTINGTON DRIVE / GARFIELD AVENUE:** Two vehicles were involved in an injury traffic collision. One of the drivers was transported to the hospital. Both vehicles were driven from the scene.

**10:07 A.M. / WARRANT ARREST / HUNTINGTON DRIVE /KENILWORTH AVENEUE:** A vehicle was stopped for a vehicle code violation. Upon further investigation, the driver, Benefiel, Jessica (DOB 09/30/92, Monrovia) had an outstanding misdemeanor warrant for reckless driving from the Arcadia Police Department. Benefiel was issued an own recongizance citation at Arcadia PD’s request and released at the scene.

**11:12 A.M. / B&P 4060, HS 11377(A), PC 4573 /PRESCRIPTION DRUG VIOLATION/POSSESSION OF A SYNTHETIC DRUG/ HUNTINGTON DRIVE / KENSINGTON ROAD:** Officers were dispatched to a call for service regarding a suspicious person. After making contact with the subject, Lara-Hernandez, Hugo (DOB 11/03/1994, Los Angeles) was found to be in possession of prescription medication that did not belong to him.

Lara-Hernandez was transported to the Alhambra Jail for booking. During processing, it was discovered that Lara-Hernandez knowingly brought methamphetamine into the jail, resulting in the add charges of H&S 11377(a) and PC 4573. Lara-Hernandez was transported to IRC in Los Angeles for housing.

**1:36 P.M. / 901T / INJURY TRAFFIC COLLISION / 1400 BLK OF SAN MARINO AVENUE:** Two vehicles were involved in an injury traffic collision. One of the drivers was treated and released at the scene. Both vehicles were driven from the scene.

**7:33 PM / FOUND PROPERTY / GARFIELD AVENUE/ MONTEREY ROAD:** A traffic stop was conducted on a vehicle for expired plates. Further investigation revealed the vehicle had license plates belonging to a different vehicle. The license plates were recovered by the officer, and booked as found property.

**Monday, January 13, 2020**

**10:10 A.M. / CVC 12500 / UNLICENSED DRIVER / SAN GABRIEL BOULEVARD/ DUARTE ROAD:** A traffic stop was conducted on a vehicle for expired registration. Upon further investigation, the driver, Argüelles Campos, Domingo (DOB 05/24/1979, Maywood) did not have a valid license. Arguelles Campos, was issued an own recognizance citation and released at the scene.

**10:23 P.M. / PC 594 / VANDALISM / 2900 BLOCK OF MONTEREY ROAD:** Victim had parked his vehicle at 1700 hours. Upon his return to at 2300 hours, he noticed his vehicle had damage from an orange paintball round.

Officers responded and arrested Ramos, Juan (DOB 03/21/79, Pasadena) he was transported to the Alhambra Jail for booking.

**3:44 P.M. / PC 459 / RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY / 1100 BLK OF KEWEN DRIVE:** Unknown suspect(s) entered victim's property by smashing a window pane to a rear French door. Suspect(s) opened a couple of drawers inside the master bedroom and forced a basement door open where they located the items that were taken.

**5:58 P.M. / 901T / TRAFFIC COLLISION WITH INJURIES / HUNTINGTON DRIVE/ OLD MILL ROAD:** Two vehicles involved in a traffic collision. One vehicle was towed AAA request by driver.

**8:48 P.M. / PC 459 / RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY / 2100 BLOCK OF EL MOLINO PLACE:** Victim arrived home to find his rear door forced open. Investigation revealed suspects cut a window screen and opened the unlocked window on the rear door and reached inside to unlock the door. The house was ransacked and electronics and jewelry were stolen. An office door attached to the detached garage was also kicked and ransacked. Three suspects were arrested approximately two hours later.

**10:35 P.M. / PC 664 / 459 / ATTEMPT RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY / 1400 BLOCK OF KENSINGTON ROAD:** Officers were dispatched to the listed location regarding suspicious circumstances. The resident stated she heard an unknown subject trying all the doors to the rear of the residence and that she had observed flashlights. While in route to the residence officers observed a suspicious vehicle leaving the immediate area and conducted a traffic stop. Upon further investigation of the subjects and the vehicle it was determined that subjects had burglarized the residence on El Molino Place and attempted to burglarize the above location. Yoakum, Marquee Antoni (DOB 03/17/2001, Los Angeles), Patterson, Jordan Narvell (DOB 05/01/2001, Los Angeles) and Allen, Russel (DOB 09/19/1988, Los Angeles) were subsequently arrested for burglary and attempt burglary, and transported to Alhambra Jail for booking and housing.
