For the period of Sunday, July 26, 2020 through Saturday, August 1, 2020, the Police Department responded to 521 calls for service. Zero residential burglaries, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

Sunday, July 26, 2020

7:07 A.M. / FALL ON CITY PROPERTY / HUNTINGTON DRIVE / SAN MARINO AVENUE: Female subject fell off her bicycle and hit her head.

5:01 P.M. / PC 484A / PC 368E / THEFT / FALSE PRETENSES / 2100 BLOCK OF ORLANDO ROAD: The reporting party stated that his brother was cashing forged checks from his former employee.

Matters was arrested for the above violations and transported to the Pasadena Jail and later issued an own recognizance citation.
