For the period of Sunday, July 5, 2020 through Saturday, July 11, 2020, the Police Department responded to 487 calls for service. Zero residential burglaries, Zero commercial burglaries, and Zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.
