For the period of Sunday, June 14, 2020 through Saturday, June 20, 2020, the Police Department responded to 561 calls for service. Zero residential burglary, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

**Sunday, June 14, 2020**
