For the period of Sunday, June 21, 2020 through Saturday, June 27, 2020, the Police Department responded to 517 calls for service. Two residential burglary, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.
