For the period of Sunday, March 1, 2020 through Saturday, March 7, 2020, the Police Department responded to 508 calls for service. One residential burglary, three commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

Sunday, March 1, 2020

11:27 A.M. / DOG BITE / LOMBARDY ROAD / CHESTER AVENUE: The victim was bit by a dog on 02/27/2020 and sustained minor injuries. At the time of the occurrence, the victim contacted the Pasadena Humane Society who made a report of the incident.

Monday, March 2, 2020

8:18 A.M. PC 532(A)/ FALSE PRETENSES/ 2700 BLOCK OF GAINSBOROUGH DRIVE: Unknown suspect(s) deceived the victim by claiming to work for a federal agency and convinced her that her social security number was associated to a crime, and was going to be removed. The suspect(s) convinced the victim to complete several wire transfers and purchase gift cards to pay lawyer fees to avoid going to jail.

2:30 P.M. / CVC 20001 / INJURY HIT & RUN / PALOMAR ROAD / HUNTINGTON DRIVE: An unknown suspect driving a black Toyota Tacoma, merged lanes without signaling and collided with victim's vehicle. The Toyota Tacoma failed to stop at the scene of the collision. One party involved complained of pain but refused medical treatment.
