For the period of Sunday, March 15, 2020 through Saturday, March 21, 2020, the Police Department responded to 418 calls for service. Three residential burglaries, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglary occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.
