For the period of Sunday, March 22, 2020 through Saturday, March 28, 2020, the Police Department responded to 374 calls for service. Two residential burglaries, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.
