For the period of Sunday, March 29, 2020 through Saturday, April 4, 2020, the Police Department responded to 397 calls for service. One residential burglary, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

Sunday, March 29, 2020

6:37 P.M. / FALL ON CITY PROPERTY / VEHICLE TOWED FOR EXPIRED REGISTRATION / SAN MARINO AVENUE / EUSTON ROAD: Female subject fell and hit her head while riding a scooter, she was transported to the hospital for treatment.

Monday, March 30, 2020

9:27 A.M. / VEHICLE TOWED / 2100 BLOCK OF HUNTINGTON DRIVE: A vehicle was towed.

Tuesday, March 31, 2020

4:52 A.M. / PC 484 / THEFT FROM VEHICLE / 1400 BLOCK OF WEMBLEY ROAD: Unknown suspect(s) entered the victim's locked vehicle and removed the victim's debit card. The suspect(s) then attempted to use the debit card to make a purchase.

11:50 A.M. / 647F / DRUNK IN PUBLIC / 800 BLOCK OF HUNTINGTON DRIVE: Officers responded to a call of a person who was possibly drunk in public. Upon arrival, officers determined that Guadianvargas, Guadalupe Ricardo (DOB 2/7/1986, Orange) was under the

influence of alcohol. Guadianvargas was placed under arrest and transported to the Alhambra City Jail for booking and housing.

AVENUE / CANTERBURY ROAD: Officers made contact with a female and male subject who were seen stopping in front of homes and looking at them. The reporting party had recognized the subject from a “Ring” notification. The Ring System alerted the local residences of male and female suspects taking packages from nearby homes several weeks ago. Upon further investigation, it was determined that the subjects contacted did not match the suspects captured on the ring video. Officers ran a records check of both subjects, it was determined that the male subject, Baca, Joshua Imanuel (DOB 4/11/1995, El Sereno) was in violation of a restraining order. Baca was placed under arrest and transported to the Alhambra City Jail for booking and housing.
