For the period of Sunday, March 8, 2020 through Saturday, March 14, 2020, the Police Department responded to 454 calls for service. Three residential burglaries, zero commercial burglaries, and one attempt residential burglary occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

**Sunday, March 8, 2020**

**11:27 A.M. / CVC 20002 / NON-INJURY HIT AND RUN / 2900 BLOCK OF WOODLAWN AVENUE:** Unknown suspect(s) collided with the victim's parked vehicle and fled the scene.

**Monday, March 9, 2020**

**11:59 A.M. / CVC 20002 / NON-INJURY HIT AND RUN / 2900 BLOCK OF WOODLAWN AVENUE:** The victim was traveling northbound on San Marino Avenue and came to a stop at the red signal, when the unknown suspect struck his vehicle. The victim was able to obtain a vehicle description.
