For the period of Sunday, May 10, 2020 through Saturday, May 16, 2020, the Police Department responded to 420 calls for service. zero residential burglaries, zero commercial burglary, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

Sunday, May 10, 2020
