For the period of Sunday, May 17, 2020 through Saturday, May 23, 2020, the Police Department responded to 447 calls for service. One residential burglary, two commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

Sunday, May 17, 2020

Upon further investigation, it was determined that Benavidez, Guadalupe Mesa (DOB 5/1/1979, Tulare) was in possession of methamphetamine and drug paraphernalia. Benavidez was issued an own recognizance citation and released in the field without incident.
