For the period of Sunday, May 3, 2020 through Saturday, May 9, 2020, the Police Department responded to 452 calls for service. Zero residential burglaries, one commercial burglary, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

**Sunday, May 3, 2020**

**6:39 P.M. / CVC 23152 / DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL / GARFIELD AVENUE/ HUNTINGTON DRIVE:** Officers were dispatched to the area regarding a single vehicle collision. Upon further investigation, the driver, Caamano, Kenneth Emmanuel (DOB 11/26/1996, Pasadena) was determined to be driving while under the influence of alcohol. Neal was transported to Alhambra Jail for booking and later released on his own recognizance.

During the subsequent investigation, it was determined that Javier, Luis Fernando (DOB 1/8/1977, Hacienda Heights), was attempting to make entry into three vehicles parked in the victim's driveway. Javier was also identified as the suspect of two additional theft from vehicles on previous dates. Javier was placed under arrest and transported to the Alhambra City Jail for booking where he was released on his own recognizance.

**10:09 A.M. / PC 484A / THEFT FROM VEHICLE / 1800 BLOCK OF TWIN PALM DRIVE:** Unknown suspect(s) removed gained access to the victim's unlocked vehicle and removed property.

**10:38 A.M. / PROPERTY FOR SAFEKEEPING / 2300 BLOCK OF MONTECITO DRIVE:** Officers conducted a check on an unoccupied vehicle parked on the roadway. Officers discovered that the vehicle had an expired registration, but had a false vehicle registration tag attached to the rear license plate. The owner of the vehicle was not located. The vehicle registration tag was confiscated and secured by the San Marino Police Department for safekeeping.
