For the period of Sunday, May 24, 2020 through Saturday, May 30, 2020, the Police Department responded to 454 calls for service. One residential burglary, one commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

**Sunday, May 24, 2020**
