For the period of Sunday, November 29, 2020 through Saturday, December 5, 2020, the Police Department responded to 408 calls for service. One residential burglary, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.
