For the period of Sunday, November 8, 2020 through Saturday, November 14, 2020, the Police Department responded to 422 calls for service. Zero residential burglaries, One commercial burglary, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.
