For the period of Sunday, October 25, 2020 through Saturday, October 31, 2020, the Police Department responded to 446 calls for service. Zero residential burglaries, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.
