For the period of Sunday, October 4, 2020 through Saturday, October 10, 2020, the Police Department responded to 439 calls for service. One residential burglary, one commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.
