For the period of Sunday, September 20, 2020 through Saturday, September 26, 2020, the Police Department responded to 491 calls for service. Zero residential burglaries, zero commercial burglaries, and zero attempt residential burglaries occurred during the reporting week. The following is a summary report of the key incidents handled by the Department during this reporting period.

**Sunday, September 20, 2020**

During the subsequent investigation, it was discovered that the vehicle was reported stolen out of Sacramento and purchased through fraudulent means. An occupant of the vehicle, Smallwood, Angela Marie (DOB 6/10/82, Eureka) was gave a fictitious name and was found to be in possession of synthetic drugs. Smallwood was transported to the Pasadena jail to later be released on her own recognizance.
